MCA REPORT

I have received our 14th continuous year of the prestigious 2019 President's Award from Mustang Club of America. The award will be displayed on our club webpage for all to see. Our club is a very active club by sponsoring and supporting car shows, participating in local benefits, cruise-ins, and parades such as the National Memorial Day Parade in Washington, D.C, several local Christmas parades and the Marine Corp Toys for Tots campaign for a total of 159 points. We needed just 100 points. For the year 2017 we earned 261 points. It also recognizes our members for taking the time to study and pass the tests required to become MCA Gold Card and certified judges. Those certified judges then volunteer to judge at MCA shows to earn their Gold cards. This is the reason I keep track of our MCA members who attend National and Grand National shows. It requires many, many hours of my time, during the year, to keep account of all our activities and to document them for submission to the MCA Presidents Award committee. Sometimes it becomes cumbersome but I want our club to receive the recognition it deserves. Of the hundreds of MCA clubs only a few receive this award which is why the award is so prestigious.

MCA's Annual Meeting and installation of our newly elected officers was cancelled because of the (COVID-19) coronavirus. The National Directors will have a short teleconference to discuss pressing items and the minutes draft will be sent to me. I will pass on that information to you when I get the draft. The Mecum Auction MCA free bidder plus 1 guest passes are no longer offered however the regular \$200.00 pass is reduced to \$100.00. Very sad news our National Head judge from 2007 to 2016, Allen Stewart, passed away November 4th. Allen was one of the original

MCA members of the early 1970's. He was also the 2nd member to join and helped create National Capital Reginal Mustang Club. A magnificent tribute to Allen, by Steve Prewitt along with several MCA members can be found in January's issue of Mustang Times, pages 8 to 10. This article is a worthy tribute for you to read.

As this is being written the US Postal Service still has not delivered my December 2020 or the January 2021 issues of Mustang Times. I have notified MCA's publisher, President, Vice President and requested the Postal Service to do a trace on these magazines. I have been told the US Postal Service is behind on their deliveries due to the rush of shipments and deliveries of coronavirus (COVID-19) vaccines to distribution centers by Fed X AND UPS. It appears these companies have passed much of their smaller postal items to US Postal Service for redelivery.

Please make the following correction: the September 3 to 5 MCA show listed last month's newsletter as a Grand National in Mustang, Oklahoma will only be a National show. A Grand National show is not normally held on an MCA anniversary year; which is held every 5 years.

We will celebrate *MCA's 45th Anniversary* April 1 to 4 at Road Atlanta raceway, Braselton, George. However, this year, in a change from previous anniversaries, we will be doing a National Show type judging for a limited number of cars. All Mustang classes will be opened with judging points being awarded for the Grill Medallion and other special awards.

On line registration for the 45th celebration, as well as Hotel availability, is through the Motosho car show system. Their website is www.motosho.com. For our new members, if any of you are planning on going to the 45th or any of the MCA shows make your show and hotel reservations early as the hotels around the show sites fill up very fast.

If something comes up that you cannot attend the show you can always cancel your hotel reservations within the time limits stated on your reservation, usually within 48 hours.
