After 19 years as MCA's Office Administrator Kristie Brown will be leaving MCA on July 4th. Since MCA is a Corporation now the Office Administrators position had to be advertised with 16 individual requirements. I quickly glanced at the 10 page Administrative Services Agreement (contract) with the job description that was posted on MCA's website (under announcement) when I logged in. The position was filled and no longer on the website. That contract agreement also detailed some of the requirements I submit to Headquarters on a timely basis.
