MCA REPORT

Ford's Motor Company's discount car purchase available under the X-PLAN has changed. Complete details of the changes can be found in Steve Prewitt "Driver's Seat" club message in April's issue of Mustang Times on page 4.

I received the following draft from the January 16th first Corporate Board of Directors meeting in 2021 via teleconference:

- The President, Steve Prewitt, called the meeting to order at 12:00 PM and welcomed all board members. Roll call was taken by Laurie Slawson resulting in 29 National Board of Director in attendance and 1 board member absent which meant a quorum was present for the meeting. No Regional Directors were present. Membership increased 35% as a result of the New Ford Bronco introduction and the Ford X-Plan.
- FINANCIAL REPORT: The Bank combined asset business checking, High Yield saving and special events' have been all accounted for and is complete except for checks written that have not cleared the bank. The Club is in great financial condition. Annual committee budgets for 2021 were approved without objection
- EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE REPORT:

- The Motosho contract was approved with no increase in cost with a large increase in coverage. Heartland Motorsports driving event in October was approved. The 45th Anniversary event was approved for April. The following appointments by MCA President Steve Prewitt were made via motion: Parliamentarian (Jim Keenan); Sergeant of Arms (Randy Weldon); Historian (Eric Tucker); Publisher (Jim Keenan); and National Head Judges (Billy Henson and Dan Trapp). Motion was passed without objection
- COMMITTEE REPORTS:
- *Administrative* – discussed all contracts that are up for renewal in 2021. Current Office Managers contract is under development and will be presented for approval at the April meeting.
- *Driving events* – 2020 events were discussed and upcoming events and programs for 2021 were discussed.
- *Insurance* – all club show liability insurance is in place for 2021 with new input via articles from Heacock Insurance Company. They are also proposing to offer track insurance for individuals.
- *Judging* – All judging tests are now on line. Certified judging has been ongoing with 47 individuals passing the test. Certificates will be presented this year. The current allotted number of judged Mustang for the 45th Anniversary is 250. Also check your March issue of “Mustang Times” as *MCA expired Gold Cards cannot be renewed by mail any more. Details are on page 8 in Marches issue of “Mustang Times”.*
- *Marketing* – Discussed the Mecum sponsorship and the move of the Mustang Museum and our current contract with them. The annual cost will be reduced from \$15,000.00 to \$5,000.00 a year due to decreased size and the museum will now give a \$2.00 discount to MCA members.
- *Membership/Special Events* – Current membership count is 19,007. Some committee members will be attending national shows and several other large non-MCA shows this year with membership information.
- *National Shows for 2021* – Eureka Spring, Arkansas; Overland Park, Kansas; Mustang, Oklahoma; and Tucson, Arizona are approved for this year. 2022 National shows – Florence, South Carolina; Suisun City,

California; Buffalo, New York; and the Grand National in Evans, Georgia are approved for 2022. NOTE: Judging points at the 2021 Tucson show for special awards will be carried over to 2022. Motion for all shows was passed without objection.

- *Nominations/Elections* – Lifetime achievement award was passed without objection to Jack and Grace Bosis.
- *Show Automation* will be using the same contract in 2021 which allows Region Shows to use Motosho

The next Corporate 2021 meetings are scheduled to take place on April 24 in Dallas, Texas; July 10 in Dallas, Texas; and October is to be determined. With no further new business to discuss the meeting was adjourned at 2:17 PM.

Two CVMC members, Tony Hall and Robin Reese attended the 45th *Anniversary Celebration* at Road Atlanta raceway, Braselton, Georgia and both their Mustangs earned Gold awards. Congratulations to both.

If any of you are looking for a rare part for your Mustang you can probably find it at the Carlisle Ford National show. Back in 1995 I needed a Ford original 1 piece exhaust and tail pipe with the required resonator, for MCA’s concours driven judging category for my 1967 6 cylinder A/T Mustang. The complete, original, welded system with Ford’s part number (C7ZA-5246-AB) on the resonator was found at Carlisle. This exhaust system is still on our Mustang.
