### Mustang Club of America news:

Everyone have a wonderful Thanksgiving with lots of food and enjoyment of family and friends.

I hope all of you reviewed the bios of those volunteering for the 2021 to 2022 MCA National Board of Directors (BOD) listed in the September issue of Mustang Times. The election ballots, for the 2<sup>nd</sup> time via Email, had to be received in Corporate Headquarters by midnight September 30<sup>th</sup>. My ballot was posted in the middle of September.

The 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter Board of Directors meeting has been cancelled and there was no reason given. This was stated in Octobers Mustang Times by our President. The election results will be published in November's issue of Mustang Times. Usually the swearing in of our new elected officers takes place in January's 1<sup>st</sup>

BOD meeting of the New Year. When I receive any additional information, I will report back to you.

The final MCA show of the season, cancelled twice, finally took place October 7 to 10 in Tucson, Arizona.

The Motosho car show registration system is now on line for registration at [www.motosho.com](http://www.motosho.com) for the April 1 Florence, S. Caroline 2022 MCA National show.

Update on the **2021 BEST of SHOW** candidates from our Fall Show

We had 99 registered vehicles for judging. The largest judged class was "Q" category with 24 Mustangs split between the years 2005 to 2019 all standard models, next largest judged class was "R" category with 10 modified Mustangs split between the years 2005 to 2019.

Only Occasionally Driven Division vehicles qualify for Best of Show awards. In addition to the 99 vehicles judged, Chris Evans & myself looked at another already judged 12 cars to choose the difficult task of finding the 4 Best of Show vehicles for the calories: *Early* and *Late Mustangs*, *Ford* product, and *Modified*. *All the winners had no point deductions.*

- **Early Mustangs:** *winner was # 7* with no point deductions; the only other Mustang in that class because it was missing a spare tire and other small items.
- **Late Mustangs:** *winner was # 120* with no deductions. The next 6 vehicles that did not qualify mainly because of engine dust, water spots, and body problems.
- **Ford:** *winner was # 50* only 1 with no point deductions
- **Modified:** *winner was # 124* with no point deductions. The next 2 vehicles that did not qualify because of dirt and dust.

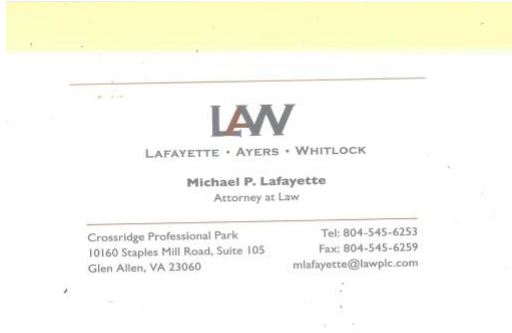
