MCA REPORT

I finished the annual report for our club to MCA Corporate Headquarters that was due by 1 March and was mailed on February 24th.

The first MCA National show of this opening car show season is April 1 – 3 in Florence; S. Carolina. The Deadline for registration was February 28, 2022.

Hotel availability for this show can be made on line through Motosho car show system. Their website is www.motosho.com.

If any of you are planning on going to this show as a spectator make your hotel reservations early as hotels around the show sites fill up very fast. If something comes up that you cannot attend the show you can always cancel your hotel reservations within the time limits stated on your reservation, usually within 48 hours.

In March's issue of Mustang Times is the application form for the Mustang Grille Medallion on page 81. For those considering trying to receive this award for your Mustang read carefully the top page requirements listed on page 81 as the old rules have changed. Because over 451 members have received this and 130 have received additional awards the judging committee has made it more difficult to earn the awards by changing the colors, several judging rules and classes. The complete list of Grille Medallion awards is listed in January's issue of "Mustang Times" on pages 50 to 55. After receiving this basic award, it entitles you to continue into the Conservator, Classic or Concept classes. These changes encourage Mustang owners to continue driving their Mustang to MCA shows. That is why this award is so prestigious.

The Spring Show flyer is now listed under the April 30th show date along with our Fall show date under September 17th in MCA's Events section on-line in their website at www.mustang.org and in the Car

Club Council of Central Virginia website under Calendar.

- The handicap and regular toilets along with a wash station have been ordered for delivery and pickup.

Our Fall September 17th MCA Regional show has been submitted to "Mustang Times" magazine to be added to their list of Mustang shows in September. It usually takes 2 or more months from submissions date to appear in the Events section of "Mustang Times" magazine.

In March's issue of "Mustang Times" on page 30 to 34 is an excellent article on George & Joy Stegner's 1968 GT 390 convertible. Take a good look at the grill as there is a difference between the 1967 & the Mustang '68 grilles. I judged George's Mustang at the Myrtle Beach, South Carolina show in 2016 where it took Gold. That enabled George to earn the Conservator class Medallion (beside the Red Medallion). That show is where I received my Red Grille Medallion for the 2005 Mustang.

"Mustang Times" is the official club publication and is included with your membership. You can NOT purchase this magazine on any newsstand or anywhere else. 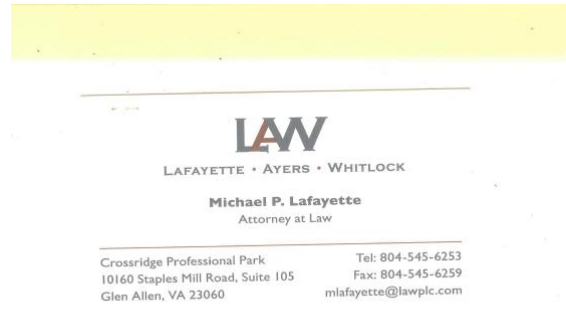
