MCA REPORT

Mustang Club of America news:

Central Virginia Mustang Club has been verified as a charter club member of Mustang Club of America.

I received my draft copy of the 1st MCA Corporate Board of Directors meeting held January 14th to 15th, 2022 in Kissimmee, Florida. The Banquet and new Officers installation dinner took place Friday evening. The Board of Directors meeting and assignments took place on Saturday the 15th at the Hotel. The President, Steve Prewitt, called the meeting to order at 6 PM and welcomed the 24 Board of Directors. Roll was taken by National Secretary Laurie Slawson resulting in quorum for the start of the meeting. 6 Board of Directors members were missing. There were 4 Regional Directors in attendance: Harold Champion (Mustang Club of Tampa/Bay Area Mustangs), Peggy Corpman (Mustang Club of Omaha), Bill Hurlock, Jr (Coastal Carolina Mustang Club); and Tina Ponder (Red River Classic Mustang Club) along with guests.

Minutes from the October 2021 Board of Directors meeting were submitted and approved without objection.

David Morton of Mecum Auto Auctions addressed the Board on the following: There will be a new bidder's pass with a PROMO discount code for all MCA members, which will be *MCA22CLUB*. With this new code members will get a 50% discount to all Mecum Auctions attendants for 2022, but you MUST use the code.

Executive Committee Report: discussed board meetings for 2022. The October meeting and Regional Directors meeting is scheduled for October near Dayton, Ohio. Steve Prewitt made the following appointments by motion: Parliamentarian (Jim Keenan); Sergeant of Arms (Randy Weldon); Historian (Eric Tucker); Publisher (Jim Keenan) and National Head Judges (Billy Henson and Dan Trapp). Motion was passed without objection.

Finance Committee Report: Treasurer's Report and 2022 Budget; Wells Fargo combined accounts (which are: regular Checking, High Yield Savings, Business checking and special events) are down by \$11,128.00 from year 2021.

- The budget committees discussed the budget and administrative office budget with a recommend of going to a new card printing machine and envelope stuffing machine to reduce administrative hours.
- Annual committee budgets for 2022 were passed, with corrections, without objection.
- Ford Motor Company remains a strong sponsor of MCA

Committee Reports:

- Administrative: committees discussed the Finance report along with new procedures with respect to club contracts.
- Club Charters: Motion to charter San Jose Mustangs Car Club of California and Bay Area Mustangs in Tampa, Florida were approved without objection.
- Driving Events: upcoming events at Heartland Motorsports Park in Topeka, Kansas, and working with Ford on the Ozarks International, in Arkansas for 2022
- Hall of Fame: Two Lifetime Achievement Award nominations, for Steve Strickell and Floyd and Ellen Scranton were discussed. Motion was approved without objection.
- Insurance: MCA is changing insurance sponsorship to Hagerty. MCA will receive \$30,000.00 a year for three years. Regional club insurance, upon request, will be made available for club regional shows
- Judging: class changes for Second Generation Unrestored Mustangs were presented. Some judging sheets have been revised.
- Marketing: a motion was made to support Eric Tucker for \$300.00 to run for a charitable cause in the Boston Marathon. Motion was approved without objection
- Membership/Special Events: Committee members will be attending national shows and several other large non-MCA shows this year (like the Ponies in the Smokies) in Sevierville, Tennessee with membership information. Worldwide current membership count is 18,407 – down by 3,093. Membership usually increases in the summer months.
- National Shows: we have received applications from Indianapolis, Indiana for July 27-30, 2023 and Savannah for October 11-13, 2024. The

motion for both shows was passed without objection. The committee will be negotiating a new date for the Des Moines, Iowa show in 2023 and possibly a date for a Mississippi show.

- Show Automation: Four National Shows are now set up along with a Regional Show.

With no further business to discuss the meeting was adjourned without objection at 9:27 pm.

The next Corporate Business meetings are scheduled to take place on Saturday, April 30, and July 9 in Dallas, Texas; and October 15-16, 2022 in Dayton, Ohio.

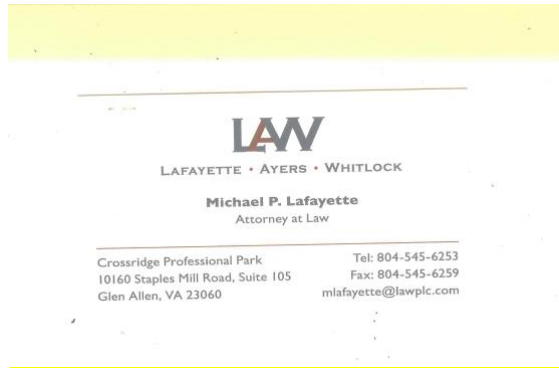
