Amy was buried on Tuesday, Aug 23<sup>rd</sup> with full military honors at the Virginia Veteran's Cemetery in Amelia. 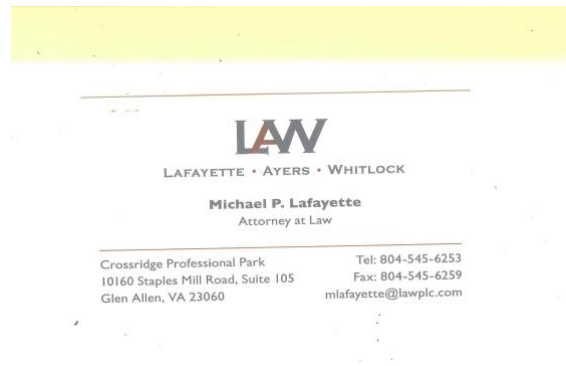
