- Meeting was adjourned at 9:05pm.

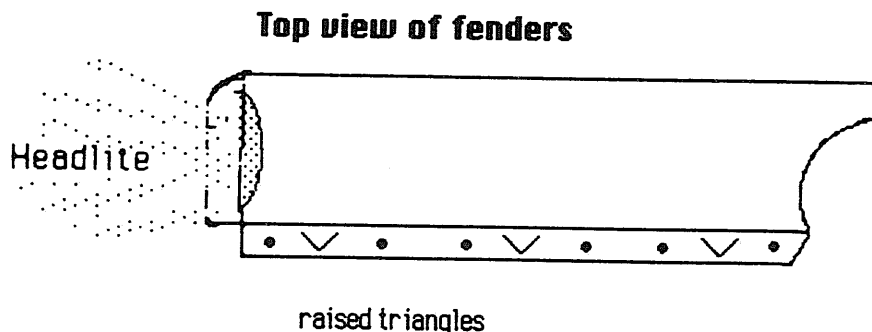

Rick's Tips

Original 1964 -1966 Ford fenders verses the 1992 Ford fender for the 1964 -1966 Mustang.

The 1964 -1966 Ford fenders produced during 1964 to 1966 are different than Ford fenders produced today for the same car.

The current Ford fenders produced today have three raised triangles stamped into the lip where the fender bolts to the inner fenders. See below.



The original Ford fender produced between 1964 to 1966 is flat on their lip and has no raised areas.

To correct this, split the raised areas, flatten and weld up. Finish off with bondo. It will be flat as originals produced in 1964 to 1966.
