Cosier. Board of Directors '94 are: Richard Jones, Manny Nichols, and Mark McChesney.


Meeting was adjourned at 8:30 p.m.

Rick's Tips

Repro Spark Plug Wire 1964 to 1966

There are some subtle and obvious differences between reproduction and original plug wires. Original wires were made with rubber that was harder and more brittle than the current soft and pliable rubber. With 25 plus years of technology separating the original and the reproduction, I had always thought that because original wires are so old that they had hardened over time. This is true to a degree but the original wires were hard to begin with.

The printing on the wires is similar but original wires had crisper printing. Hi-po wires had red or blue printing were as the reproductions are in white. Also hi-po wires had Fomoco cast in the boot.

The final difference between the original and reproduction is probably the most interesting. The original wire have a very light green tint on them. If you ever happen to see an original set of wires the green tint is visible and was a protective coating placed on the wires when new. It makes them look like they have clear coating on them.
