

The Azalea parade was an enormous success. I would like to thank all that participated, and would also like to thank Nellie for the decorations for the cars. To all a job well done!



64-66 Dual Exhaust tip update

On Mustangs with dual exhaust, the exhaust tips that come out the rear panel will not line up. After putting dual exhaust on a half a dozen cars I have found the tip coming out the panel is not bent correctly. The pipe must be heated and reshaped. Apparently the molds for the left exhaust tip which were mass produced were incorrectly set. Don't feel discouraged if this happens to you.
