CENTRAL VIRGINIA MUSTANG CLUB
SEPTEMBER 6, 1995

The September meeting of the Central Virginia Mustang Club was called to order by President Kenny Fischer at 7:41 pm. Greetings to all those present and a special welcome was extended to guests and prospective members. Mustangs owned by guests included a '67 coupe, a '73 convertible, a '93 5.0, and a '66 coupe. Birthday greetings were wished to those born in September. Second Vice-President Terry Wagner reported 72 members. Treasurer George Cosier reported a beginning balance of \$923.05 minus \$102.08 (newsletter), minus \$24.90 (Lilac & Lace), minus \$22.85 (telephone), minus \$23.14 (telephone), minus \$35.35 (Lilac & Lace), minus \$140.40 (trophies), minus \$51.21 (CopyCat Printing), plus \$505.00, plus 159.50 for an ending balance of \$1313.83.

National Director Paul Oliver attended the August 8 MCA Board of Directors meeting in Atlanta. MCA is promoting a cruise called Cruise Royal Caribbean Escapes Unlimited next August 10-17, 1996. The cost will be \$899-999 per person. Tentative guest speakers on the cruise will be Carroll Shelby and Steve Saleen. There will be an additional \$115 port charge. MCA is developing new pins with the new logo. MCA won't allow commercial use of the MCA mailing list but the list will be available to regional clubs to solicit new members. The bulletin board computer is dead, Andy Richardson has left the organization. The museum has been incorporated in Michigan. To promote MCA, the organization has given us some back issues of Mustang Times to distribute at our show to prospective members. It was noted that pages are stuck together on these issues.

Director Carroll Lipscombe reported up-coming parades: October 14 will be the October Fest Parade at 6:30 pm. Richard Dawson needs convertibles for VIPs at 5:00 pm, there will be lots of television coverage. October 21 will be the Midlothian Village Parade. And December 3 will be the Chester Jaycees Christmas Parade. Karen Lane reminded everyone of the Leaf Cruise scheduled for October 22. Planning for the Holiday Party on December 16 will begin after the car show. Nellie Fischer needs advertisements for the program, articles for the newsletter, and has the usual merchandise. Brenda Jones presented the doorprizes and refreshments. Marty Belt will have more to say about NASCAR next week, after the race. A welcome back was extended to Marty on his recovery from open heart surgery. Monte Evans was not present to present trivia. Bonnie Fischer asked to any photos for the scrapbook.


First Vice-President Don Lane announced that the judges will have red hats for the car show to distinguish them from members. There will be a technical inspection at registration. This will neither help nor hurt, but may serve as a tie-breaker. Please see Kenny if anyone is interested in sponsoring a trophy class. The cost is \$60.00 for first through third places. Kenny used the Ford hotline to solicit merchandise for the show. Ford sent back-issues of Road & Track Magazine and Reflections posters. There are several items posted on the bulletin board for sale -- please check the board during the break.

Lite 98 radio will be providing a live-remote from our show from 12:00 pm - 3:00 pm. Bill Bevins will be the disc jockey. The station

will be doing advertisements this week on the air. The Hooter's girls will be there from 12:00 pm - 3:00 pm. Perhaps they will sell the 50/50 tickets to benefit the Scouts. About 6 members are needed to come to Willow Lawn on Friday night to help rope off the area for the show. Kenny plans to be there by 7:00 am Saturday, registration will begin at 8:00 am to 12:00 pm. Twelve dozen donuts have been donated by Krispy Kreme for the show for the early birds. Coffee is questionable. Trailer parking will be on the Jones' Auto Service parking lot. Kenny purchased an 8x10 canopy to use for registration and a 10x16 canopy to use by the travel trailer to serve as an information point. The trailer is 25 feet long, we believe, and air conditioned. There are nice doorprizes for participants, and a grab bag for every entrant. There will be separate lines for pre-registered and those not pre-registered to enter the show area. We will try to group cars by class. We will have plaques cut in the shape of Virginia with a CVMC medallion instead of trophies, engraved on the bottom. Judging will be along the lines of MCA with a point spread. Willow Lawn has a public address system we will be able to use. Kenny has tables to use for trophy and prize displays. Each participant will receive a judging sheet at registration, this is to be left on the car dash or under the windshield wiper at all times. The owner needs to fill out the name and VIN.

Brenda reported that the three trophy winners from Rocky Mount will soon receive information from Bill Weaver of the Tarheel Mustang Club regarding the VIN discarded by MCA before they were engraved on the trophies.





