Remember I will have a Board meeting Jan. 14 at 4pm., at my house.



Second Vice-President Terry Wagner reported 85 members, including one new tonight. Treasurer George Cosier reported a beginning balance of \$1268.09 - \$15.00 (Chester Jaycees Christmas Parade) - \$22.85 (phone) - \$138.06 (newsletter) - \$75.92 (Pizza Hut for Adopt-A-Highway) + 21.00 + 116.00 = \$1153.26 final balance.
