We will have flyers for our show at the next meeting to start generating around.



Rick's tips

Repro Windshield Weatherstrip.....

The windshield weatherstrip is the black rubber that surrounds the front windshield on 1964 thru 1968 mustangs. The price of the repro windshield weatherstrip has dropped to an all time low at \$9.95. This is the same weatherstrip that used to sell for around \$30.00. What has occurred is there has been a new run of these weatherstrips and they are too thin to get a good seal around the windshield. Until the manufacturer retools and makes these thicker, all repro weatherstrips should be avoided. Unfortunately the Ford weatherstrip is approximately \$70.00. Unless you want a lake of water in your car after a rain or after a washing, I would suggest using the Ford.

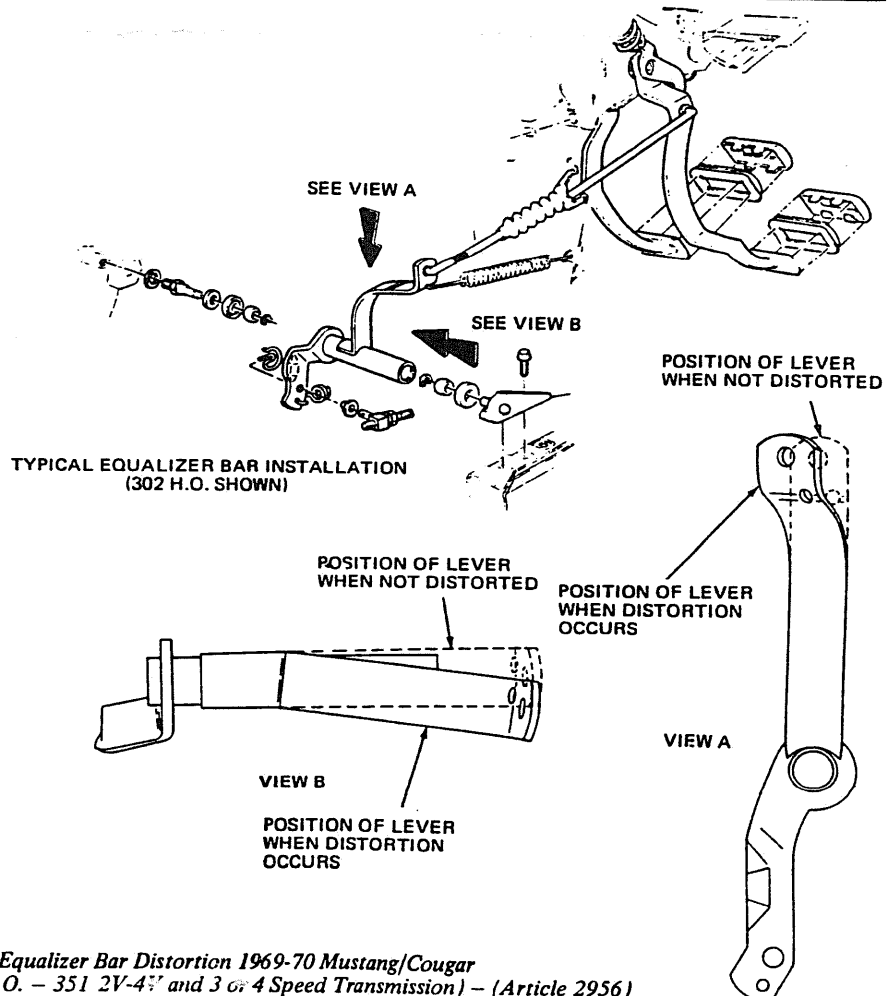


Figure 6 - Clutch Equalizer Bar Distortion 1969-70 Mustang/Cougar (302 H.O. - 351 2V-4¹/₂ and 3 or 4 Speed Transmission) - (Article 2956)

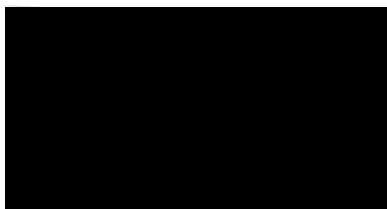
