President's Perspective

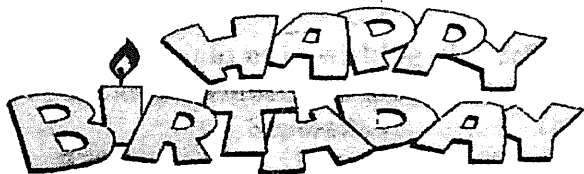
Welcome members,

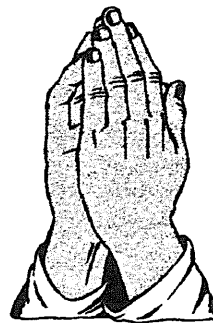

MINUTES OF THE CENTRAL VIRGINIA MUSTANG
MEETING OF SEPTEMBER 1, 1999
