THE NEXT MEETING ON JUNE 7, 2000 AT RICHMOND FORD, UPSTAIRS

CENTRAL VIRGINIA MUSTANG CLUB
MAY 3, 2000

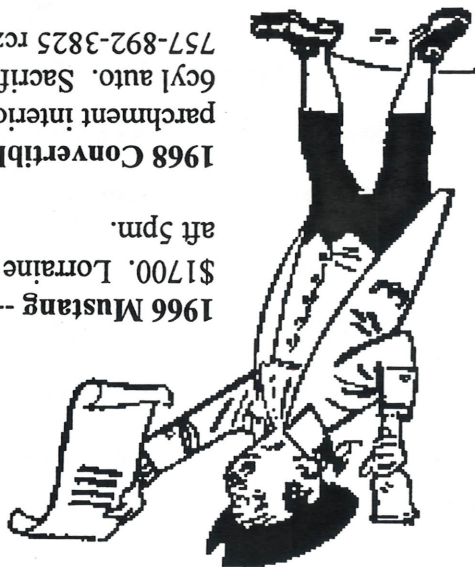

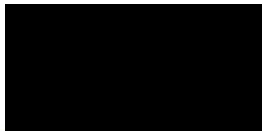
