MILITARY AVIATION MUSEUM CRUISE

May 18, 2024



Ready for a great Cruise to the Military Aviation Museum in Pungo, Virginia (Virginia Beach) to check out some fascinating Military Aircraft from World War II and World War I?

Meet at 10:00am, Leave at 10:15am: Pilot Travel Center, 4610 County Drive (U.S. Route 460) Just east of I-295.

Directions:

We will travel east on U.S. Route 460 to U.S. Route 58 in Suffolk, Va. We will then take U.S. Route 58 east to I-64. We will then travel on I-64 west toward Indian River Road in Virginia Beach (yes, you read right). We will take Indian River Road in a southeast direction toward W. Neck Road.

There we take a right on W. Neck Road in a southeast direction to Princess Anne Road. We then turn right and take Princess Anne Road in southernly direction to Jerrassic Park which is the entrance to the Military Aviation Museum.

The trip will take approximately 2 hours. Admission to the Museum is \$17 for Adults; \$10 for Youths (5-13); Free for under 4, and Includes the Summer of Flight Demonstrations.

Summer of Flight

Experience Warbirds in flight this Summer! Saturdays at 1pm from May to October, the Military Aviation Museum will be showcasing historical aircraft and commemorating important wartime events through narrated flying demonstrations.

Experience the rumble from the engine up close as you hear from the pilots about what it is like to fly these incredible aircraft, learn about the battles they participated in, and about the men and women who built, flew and maintained them during the war!

I have confirmation from MCA Headquarters that our club record's from 2023 has been updated for 2024.

For those of you that do not receive the "Mustang Times" magazine, MCA's Mustangs 60th Anniversary Celebration will be held at Barber Motorsports Park in Leeds, Alabama on April 5-7, 2024. "Check the MCA website for the various registrations, RV parking, and spectator passes".

The show banquet is sold out! Judging will be for only 400 Mustangs and that is now closed. You can still register for this fantastic event to display your Mustang (NOT JUDGED) as a spectator, as of 4 PM, 22 March the website said display registration closing soon, however the website was still up. As of today the Host Hotel, Marriott Birmingham's discounted rated is sold out; there are the Hampton Inn, Candlewood Suites along with other hotels in the surrounding area to register. Check with those hotels as some may have booking deadlines for the 60th at the website www.MCAshows.com.

There will NOT be an MCA Grand National show when we have a birthday celebration year show.

For those that are driving to the Celebration, the March issue of Mustang Times tells you the 60th registration is off site with instructions, a map on how to get to the registration mall site on page 10, directions to the Park track and a Parking guide on page 33. For those who have never been to a Mustang Anniversary Celebration I can tell you that it is a celebration not to miss, it is tremendous. I spent 1 week volunteering at the 50th Anniversary at Charlotte Motor speedway where the best of the best Mustangs were driven to be viewed along with a Hugh assortment of Mustang suppliers.
