Ready for a great Cruise to the Military Aviation Museum in Pungo, Virginia (Virginia Beach) to check out some fascinating Military Aircraft from World War II and World War I?

Meet at 10:00am, Leave at 10:15am: Pilot Travel Center, 4610 County Drive (U.S. Route 460) Just east of I-295.

#### Directions:

We will travel east on U.S. Route 460 to U.S. Route 58 in Suffolk, Va. We will then take U.S. Route 58 east to I-64. We will then travel on I-64 west toward Indian River Road in Virginia Beach (yes, you read right). We

will take Indian River Road in a southeast direction toward W. Neck Road.

There we take a right on W. Neck Road in a southeast direction to Princess Anne Road. We then turn right and take Princess Anne Road in southernly direction to Jerrassic Park which is the entrance to the Military Aviation Museum.

The trip will take approximately 2 hours. Admission to the Museum is \$17 for Adults; \$10 for Youths (5-13); Free for under 4, and Includes the Summer of Flight Demonstrations.

Experience Warbirds in flight this Summer! Saturdays at 1pm from May to October, the Military Aviation Museum will be showcasing historical aircraft and commemorating important wartime events through narrated flying demonstrations.
