Once again, it is time for our annual Fall Show at Bass Pro Shops in Ashland on Sat, Sep 19, 2026. As of July 20th, there are 42 vehicles registered for the show. (Last year we had 45 at this time.) Hopefully, many more will register to reach our limit of 155 vehicles. I encourage you to call your friends who own Mustangs or any Ford vehicle and invite them to register and attend.

Of course, we have a great lineup of vendors and sponsors that include the following:

It all starts with assembly of the registration packets at 5 PM on Wed, Sep 16th at Ron Martin's house. It is a lot of fun with pizza and beverages provided. We could use about a dozen or 15 volunteers for this activity. Next is marking the parking spaces and vendor assigned areas at Bass Pro Shops at 6 PM on Fri, Sep 18th. We could use from six to eight people to help here. It can easily be done in an hour with enough help.

Finally, the day of the show is on Sat, Sep 19th. We need volunteers as early as 7 AM to help setup the registration area that includes the tent(s), the tables, chairs, computers, generator, trash receptacles and more. As the day goes on, we need volunteers to help with directing cars to their assigned space in the parking lots. I know Curtis will enjoy help here. Of course, Chris Evans, our head judge, needs volunteers to judge cars too. After the show is over, we need help with taking everything down and storing it once again in the club trailer.

Let's hope we have cooler weather without any chance of rain! That will work for me.



I received confirmation on 7 July, the 2025 MCA Presidents Award application has been received at Headquarters. We accumulated the 100 points we needed to qualify CVMC and submitted our earned 214 points. After the award committee reviews my application hopefully they will agree and award our club MCA's Presidents award for the 20th continuous year!.

The Mustang 50th Anniversary in Braselton, GA is August 28-30 at Road Atlanta. The banquet is **sold out**. The Shelby Club of America is joining us to celebrate their 51st Anniversary. If you are interested in driving on the track or judging you need to register now as those spaces and judging are almost closed. There is no MCA *Grand National* celebration this year when we have an anniversary celebration. To register for any of those show activities you **must** register using MCA's registration website www.mcashows.com, and look for the show you want to register for. Most everyone knows MCA show locations fill up fast so make your hotel reservations early. If something comes up and you cannot attend the show, you can always cancel your hotel reservations within the time limits stated on your hotel reservation; usually within 48 hours

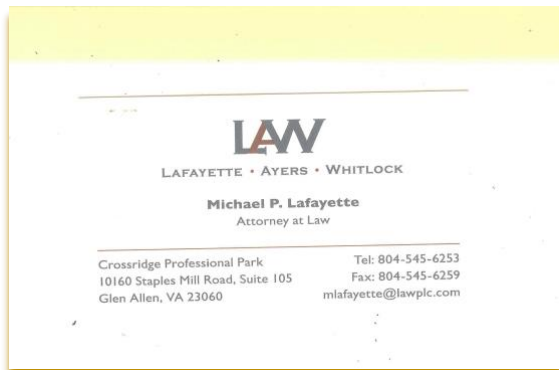
