CVMC has been invited to have a Cruise In at Ford's Garage. The time is from 9am to 11am. Most of us will be staying to have lunch after the Cruise In.

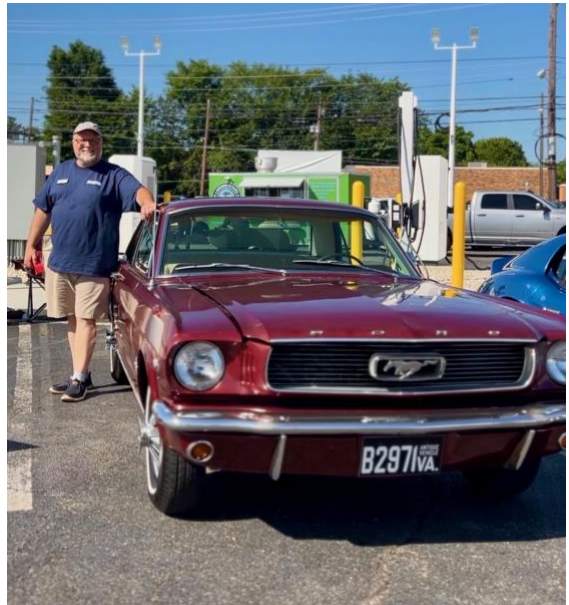

The Bass Pro Shop Fall Show poster pictures of our clubs 3 Mustangs have been taken, read, proofed and the printers did a quick turnaround. I will have the September 19th posters at our Wednesday business meeting for everyone to pick up and deliver to your favorite businesses.

Our fall show at Bass Pro Shops in Ashland is now published in our magazine, page 77 and on Car Club Council of Central Virginia's events calendar.

For those club members that have antique (Mustangs), 25 years or older, Virginia *does* have a *tax exemption* registration *fee* for those cars. There will be some copies of an article regarding this at the meeting.

Most of the late model cars produced, now being sold, have electric powered steering. I just saw advertised in

the back section of "Mustang Times" electric power steering units now available for the 1st Generation Mustangs.

Many CVMC members who worked or had their Mustangs in the National Capital Region Mustang clubs MCA's Grand National show in Fredericksburg in August of 2025 check this out. There is a fantastic article with pictures of the 2 week Washington Convention Center (WANADA) auto show in June's issue of "Mustang Times" on pages 58-59. This show was held during the gigantic ice and snow storm in February of this year. Many years ago (1980's) Judi's 1967 Sprint 6 Mustang won an award in the *former* building where that association now holds their auto shows, which is huge, in comparison to our Richmond Convention automobile shows.

For those members who do not receive "Mustang Times" you will find a complete listing of the 2026 MCA National Shows by going to the website www.mustang.org, choose event, then MCA Calendar date by scrolling down for the date and location of the MCA show you are looking for.

To register for any of those shows you **must** register using MCA's registration website www.mcashows.com, and look for the show you want to register for. Most everyone knows the show locations fill up fast so make your hotel reservations early. If something does come up and you cannot attend the show, you can always cancel your hotel reservations within the time limits stated on your hotel reservation; usually within 48 hours

For our new members you can join MCA on line. There are 4 different tier levels (1 for overseas country membership) discussed in MCA's website www.mustang.org. "Mustang Times" is the official club publication. Included with your membership is access to Ford's X-Plan pricing and is available in the USA to current Digital and Standard members. The only way to obtain this distributed magazine is with your membership application. Worldwide membership is over 15,000 and growing. 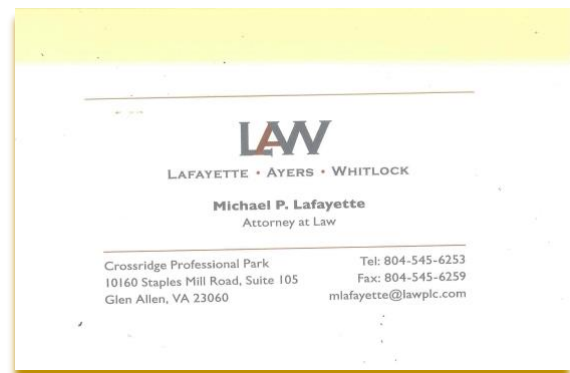
